School

International Christian University High School (ICUHS) is a Japanese private senior high school located in Tokyo. There are 239 private high schools in Tokyo, and their number and standard of education exceed those of metropolitan high schools. Our school is ranked as one of Tokyo's top private high schools. International Christian University, which our school is affiliated with, is rated 11th overall and 1st among private universities in the Times Higher Education's Japan University Rankings 2025.

ICUHS was founded in 1978 with the primary purpose of accepting returnee students, i.e., Japanese students who have been living overseas and attending schools there. Two-thirds of our students are returnees from over 50 countries, and at ICUHS they study alongside students who have received all their education in Japan. Apart from those English classes which are taught in English (i.e. all except English Grammar and related electives), all classes are taught in Japanese, in accordance with the Japanese national curriculum. However, we also offer diverse educational programs and an expanded English language program to cater to the needs of students with a variety of educational backgrounds.

Curriculum

We offer many required courses in academic subjects. All students study multiple fields. Grading is based on the results of five regular examinations per year, taking into account the relative position of the students in the student body. In some subjects, notably English, grades are based on coursework as well as exams.

SAT

ICUHS students who take the SAT are usually returnees who are placed in the higher-level English classes. They use their scores to enter universities in Japan and overseas. The following table relates to the graduating classes of 2025 and 2026. A total of 111 students from these two years took the SAT at least once. The numbers in the EBRW and Math boxes are based on each student's highest score in the Evidence-based Read & Writing and Mathematics sections. The SAT test dates are from March 2023 to August 2025.
